

To Prospective Co-op Members:

When you join the Co-op, you not only become a member, you become an important part of a vibrant community. As a member, you may purchase goods at wholesale prices from United Foods Distributor, Frontier Natural Products, local vendors and farmers, fair trade vendors, and other suppliers. Ordering is easy and done from the comfort of your own home with our award-winning on-line ordering system. (Well, we haven't actually won any awards, but if there was such an award, we would win it!) You also have a Co-op job you are expected to perform once a month in a timely fashion. And importantly, you will meet many interesting people, some of whom may become life-long friends.

We are looking for interested, interesting and committed members. Please check us out prior to applying. We invite prospective members to visit our site during our monthly work & pick-up days to fully understand how the Co-op works. During those times you are welcome to shop in our "Extras" store, and pay just 10% above wholesale. Once you become a member, you will pay just 2% above wholesale prices. This extra fee covers our costs of operations.

There is a one-time non-refundable new member fee of \$38 when you join the co-op. You must also make a refundable \$50 deposit, which will be returned should you leave the co-op.

Once you have checked us out and are interested in joining, please fill out the attached form and mail it to the address listed on the bottom along with a check made out to "TBC" for \$88. We will hold your check until your application has been accepted and you have agreed to a particular job. Once your check is deposited, you become an official member and you can begin enjoying all the benefits. The entire process of joining can take up to a month or two.

Please understand that jobs are assigned based on member availability. If we do not have job openings during the times you are able to work, you may be placed on a waiting list. During your time on the waiting list, you are welcome to shop the extras at the non-member rate of 10% above wholesale. We work very hard to offer every applicant a job in a timely manner so that your membership can begin right away. We will not cash your check if you are on the waiting list.
